

RESOLUTION NO.289

RECIPIENT COUNTRY STATUS OF KENYA

THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS

Recalling Resolution No. 259 of the Board of Governors which approved the Amendment to Article 1 of the Agreement Establishing the Bank (the “Agreement”) to enable a limited and incremental expansion of the geographic scope of Bank’s operations to Sub-Saharan Africa and Iraq (the “Amendment”);

Noting that the requirements for accepting the Amendment, provided for under Article 56 of the Agreement, have been met on 18 April 2025, as formally communicated to members on 22 April 2025, and that the Amendment entered into force for all members on 22 July 2025;

Recalling that, by letter dated 25 March 2024, the Republic of Kenya requested to become a member of the Bank and to be granted recipient country status, and that the Republic of Kenya became a member of the Bank on 15 July 2025;

Having considered the report of the Board of Directors to the Board of Governors on the “Recipient Country Status of Kenya”, and being in agreement with its conclusions, amongst others, that the Republic of Kenya, as from the entry into force of the Amendment, complies with the requirements of Articles 1 and 2 of the Agreement Establishing the Bank to be granted Recipient Country status;

HEREBY RESOLVES THAT:

The Republic of Kenya be granted Recipient Country status as of the date of this Resolution.
