Invitation to participate in public market consultation for procurement of consultancy services for Project Management Unit support

Background

State Enterprise "Chornobyl Nuclear Power Plant" (ChNPP) intends to tender Project Management Unit (PMU) Consultancy Services funded from International Chornobyl Cooperation Account (ICCA) and administered by European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) in the Nuclear Safety Sector in Ukraine. The tender launch is planned in July 2025. This procurement exercise will be conducted using the EBRD Client E-Procurement Portal (ECEPP). As part of the preparatory activities ChNPP will hold a preliminary market consultation in July, 2025.

The Contract for provision of consultancy services will include development of Work Plan for ICCA and ChNPP PMU support during a period of three years. The objective of the assignment is to support ChNPP in management of project implementation and contract administration for on-going activities financed by ICCA, assist in the procurement of further four contract as well as their implementation and management in accordance to highest standards and best practices The consultant shall ensure that at the end of the assignment ChNPP PMU staff are self-sufficient to implement activities and projects under standards deemed acceptable by the international donors. While providing this support, the consultant will be required to deliver continuous training, knowledge transfer, development of related procedures for PMU as well as provision of an essential set of project management equipment.

The Consultant shall support the PMU in implementation and management of current contracts which include:

- Supply of specialised vehicles (in 4 lots expected in June 2026).
- Development of a working project for the Facility "Reconstruction of parts of the deaerator rack and the engine room of the "Shelter" facility of the ChNPP.
- Supply of vacuum evaporation plant. Expected delivery mid 2027.
- Additional volumes for the vacuum evaporation plant.
- Modernization of spent nuclear fuel storage facility No. 1 in terms of completion of: a) creation of a radiation monitoring system, b) technical re-equipment.
- Works and services to restore the functionality of the new safe confinement at the Chernobyl Nuclear Power Plant after the Russian military attack on February 14, 2025.

New contracts shall be tendered under EBRD's Procurement Policy and Rules and will include repair and decommissioning works in Chornobyl Power Plant, supply of equipment and related services, assist in development of requirements as well as related licences and permits from regulators.

Under the task to prepare the Work Plan for ICCA, the consultant will be required to review available recent documentation on envisaged activities to restore full functionality of the New Safe Confinement and dismantling shelter. The primary purpose of the Work Plan is to outline and justify the priority activities in the medium-term perspective. It should establish the sufficient level of accountability and transparency for planned activities, set of assumptions, baseline schedule, interrelationship with other on-going and planned ones, cost estimates, as well as provide essential justification for each of the activities (such as certain scope of long-term functionality repair works of NSC, provision of necessary IT infrastructure, removal of some unstable parts of the temporary shelter, spent fuel management, or similar).

Currently the envisaged consultant's team shall consist of Key-Experts (KEs), including team leader (PMU director) capable of leading the preparation of Work Plan for ICCA, Procurement/Commercial KE and Technical KE. In addition, the Consultant should propose a team of Non-Key Experts (NKEs) which involvement may be required from time to time. The later shall include a range of nuclear sector technical experts, in areas like nuclear safety, robotics, civil engineering, HVAC, etc.

Contract will be subject to the EBRD's Procurement Policies and Rules and are open for participation for firms from any country, unless otherwise specified in the procurement documents.

Currently, the tender documentation including qualification criteria and technical requirements are being developed.

The purpose of this event is to acquaint potential participants with the main scope of services of the assignment, conditions of the future tender and to receive their feedback and comments on the qualification criteria, technical specifications and terms of the contract.
