5. Regional: Small Business Initiative - Annual Review for 2018 and Strategic Priorities (under Financial Intermediaries Framework, Risk Sharing Framework and Direct Finance Framework SME)

#### **Minutes**

- The Board of Directors approved the headroom allocations for delegated approval of exposures of EUR 25 million or less for the three Small Business Initiative Frameworks for the period between the date of approval of this document and the date of approval by the Board of Directors of the annual headroom allocations for 2020, as follows:
  - Financial Intermediaries Framework: EUR 750 million
  - Risk Sharing Framework: EUR 150 million
  - Direct Financing Framework SME: EUR 150 million
- The Board of Directors also approved the proposed change to the operational modalities of the Risk Sharing Framework.
- 6. Ukraine: USELF: Dnepro-Bugsky Wind (under Ukraine: Sustainable Energy Lending Facility III)
- The Board of Directors approved an A/B loan of up to EUR 62.8 million, of which up to EUR 52.8 million A-loan from the EBRD's own resources and an up to EUR 10 million from Participants to Dnepro Bugzky Wind Power Station LLC. The loan will be used to finance the 110 MW Dnepro-Bugsky wind project located in the Kherson region in Ukraine.
