# 5. Mongolia: GCF GEFF Regional FW – Khan Bank Regional: Green Climate Fund – Green Economy Financing Facilities (GCF-GEFF) Framework

• The Board approved a senior loan to Khan Bank in the amount of up to USD 60 million (EUR 53 million), of which up to USD 45 million (EUR 40 million) will be provided by the EBRD and up to USD 15 million (EUR 13 million) will be provided by the Green Climate Fund ("GCF"). The loan will be used for financing investments in climate change mitigation and adaptation technologies by local clients, in line with the standards and reporting requirements of the GCF-GEFF Mongolia Policy Statement.
