5. Türkiye: Ankara Metro Project (under: Green Cities Framework 2 Window II Extension 2 Framework)

• The Board of Directors approved a loan of EUR 125 million to Ankara Metropolitan Municipality. The loan will support the construction of 7.5 km Dikimevi–Natoyolu Metro Line, including eight stations in Ankara. The project is a 'follow-on investment' under Ankara's GCAP.
