

GENERAL RULES

- The organisers of the Contest are the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (“FAO”) and the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (“EBRD”), collectively (the “Organisers”).
- The Contest is open only to individuals and teams (maximum 3 individuals) (“Entrants”). Individuals who join teams must meet the same eligibility requirements as individuals. Entrants need to have reached the age of 18 at the time of entering the Contest. FAO and EBRD employees and their immediate family members (spouses, parents, children, siblings and their respective spouses, regardless of where they live) or persons living in the same households of such employees, whether or not related, are not eligible to enter the Contest. FAO and EBRD will determine eligibility at their sole discretion.
- Copyright of the material remains with the entrants. By entering the contest, entrants grant an irrevocable, perpetual, worldwide exclusive license to FAO and to EBRD, for non-commercial purposes, to reproduce, distribute, display and create derivative works of the entries (along with a name credit) in connection with the contest and the promotion of FAO’s or EBRD’s work, in, amongst others:
 - o FAO corporate website: www.fao.org.
 - o EBRD’s corporate website: www.ebrd.com
 - o Corporate videos or digital recordings to illustrate the work of FAO or EBRD.
 - o Printed FAO or EBRD publications, brochures or posters.
 - o Social media channels of FAO or EBRD, including promotion of the contest itself;
 - o Any other media used by FAO or EBRD to communicate.
- Entrants can only submit to the Contest original works for which they are the sole creator(s) and own the copyright. If the apps make use of third party material, Entrants must have obtained the permission of the rights holders for use of the material in the Contest, as well as for use by the Organisers in the end product for the purposes described below. The Organisers will not seek additional approvals in connection with the use of the apps and will not be responsible for any claim or complaint alleging violation of the rights of third parties.
- The Organisers will not pay any fees for, nor pay any costs relating to, the entry of the app(s) and works derived from there into the competition or for their use as described above.
- The Organisers reserve the right to verify the eligibility of any entry and/or Entrant (including an Entrant’s identity and address) and to disqualify any Entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these rules or who tampers with the entry process. By submitting entries to the Contest, Entrants agree that personal data, especially name and address, may be processed, shared, and otherwise used for the purposes and within the context of the Contest and any other purposes outlined in these rules. The data may also be used by the Organisers in order to verify the Entrant's identity, postal address and telephone number or to otherwise verify the Entrant's eligibility to participate in the Contest. The Organisers are not responsible for any entries not received due to internet or software failures.

- Nothing in the rules for this Contest, nor any acts performed or statements made in relation to this Contest, shall be deemed a waiver, express or implied, of any of the privileges and immunities of FAO or the EBRD.
